

Cabarrus Homelessness Indicators

January - June 2022

Opportunity House

registered **29** new clients per month in the first quarter and **36** per month in the second quarter. A **24%** increase representing **195** new clients year to date.

Cooperative Christian Ministry

received **309** applications for housing. A **71%** increase from **38** per month to **65** per month quarter to quarter.

Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City Schools

reported **614** students as homeless during the 21/22 School year. Adjusted down to **478** due to underage siblings being included.

Rental Assistance

CCM financial assistance applications for housing averaged **92** per month in the first quarter and **154** per month in the second quarter representing a **67%** increase.

Cabarrus County Evictions

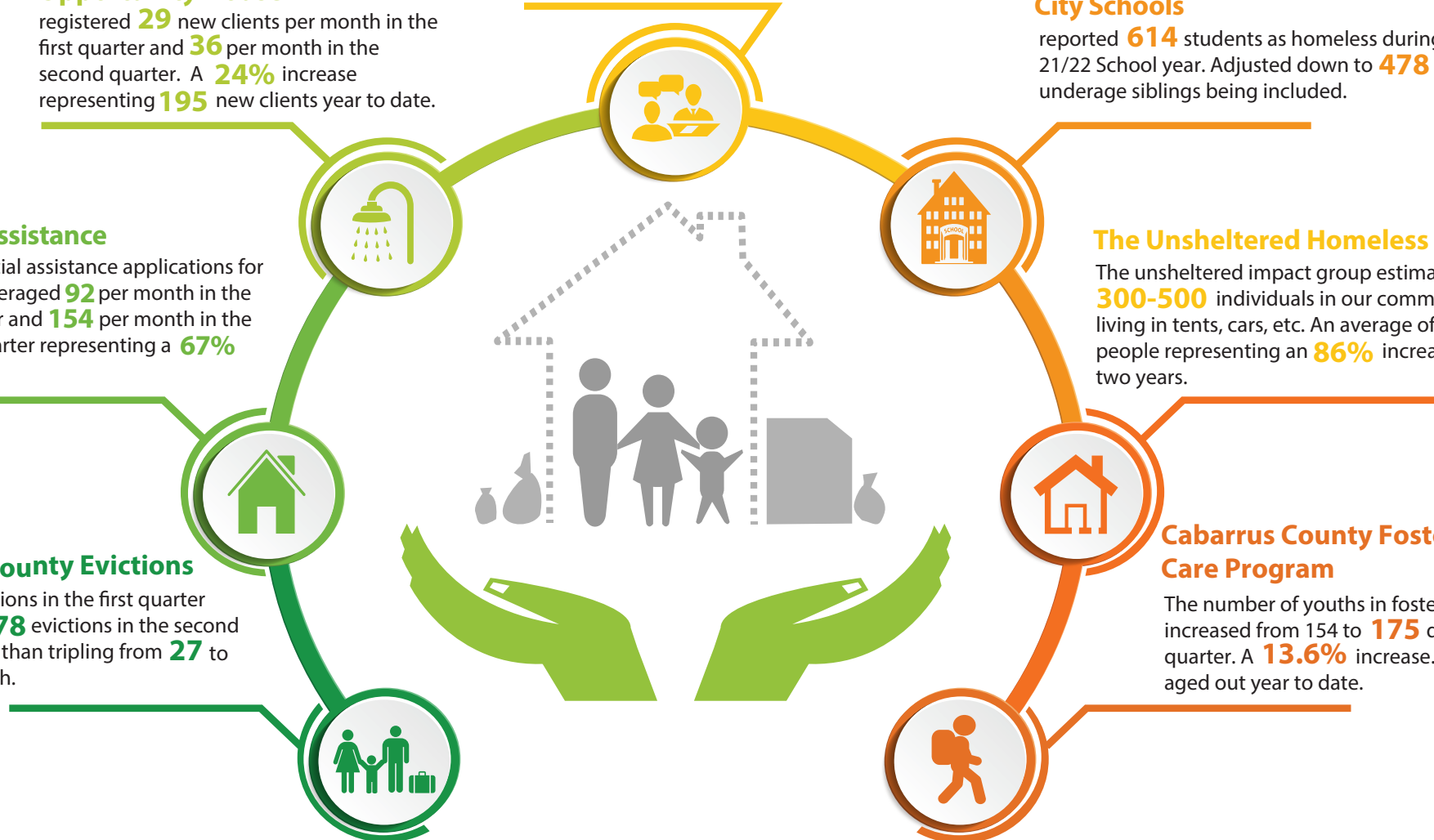
After **81** evictions in the first quarter there were **278** evictions in the second quarter. More than tripling from **27** to **93** per month.

The Unsheltered Homeless

The unsheltered impact group estimates **300-500** individuals in our community living in tents, cars, etc. An average of **346** people representing an **86%** increase in two years.

Cabarrus County Foster Care Program

The number of youths in foster care increased from 154 to **175** quarter to quarter. A **13.6%** increase. Three aged out year to date.
